




"Segment 1"

EXAMPLE 5

Titus - Vertical Chart

Div. 1 - Living in Grace

Paul calls himself a servant and an apostle. He is someone who can be submitted to.

Faith is furthered through preaching

Personal letter to Titus, an uncircumcised Gentile (Gal 2:3) and who is a true child in the midst of false.

What needed amending? "was defective?"

A. Lack of sound doctrine

B. Lack of good deeds

Synonymous Terms:

- Elder
- Bishop
- God's Steward

Both do this

All talk and no action

5 groups of people are addressed in this paragraph

What you do -What you say

Sound doctrine is godliness, a godly character

(Note: God called "Savior" 1:3, 2:13, 3:4)

Partners in the faith

Share same faith

Appoint: Titus is given the authority to select the elders from those within the fellowship.

Solution to the problem is good leaders

Summary of what their behavior, lifestyle should be. Qualifications deal with

- Character
- Family life
- Doctrine

Two groups of insubordinate men

- Circumcision party
- Cretans

Cretans were probably taught by the Circumcision party:

- Taught the law (1:14-15) ___
- Reject truth (1:14)
- Corrupt/unbelieving (1:15)
- Detestable (1:15)
- Disobedient (1:15)

- 1. Create a <u>pure</u> people
- 2. Zealous for good deeds

Who are authorities, rulers?


